6. Wire Frog: A piece of the overhead where _____ come together, near a Turnout.
7. All _____ must have a copy of these Rules available to them while on duty. All Operating Personnel must _____ the Rules _____ and _____ until they are thoroughly _____ with all of

the Rules. The General Manager will keep an up-to-date copy of the Rules on or near all operating On-Rail-Equipment.

8. While on duty or subject to duty abstain entirely from the use of _____, _____ and _____ that might adversely affect performance.
9. No employee will be allowed to be _____ from duty without permission, except if an employee feels that a physical, mental or medical condition impairs the ability to _____ carry out duties, the employee _____ go off duty, even if it means the Car cannot be operated for the public.
10. If any Operating Personnel observes a possible _____ by another Operating Person, the _____ should be discussed in private between the Operating Personnel. Any such Rules violation that is _____ by such discussion should be reported to the General Manager _____. Any significant Rules violation should be reported to the General Manager.

12. If the Car must be moved in _____, the Conductor or another qualified person must be on the _____ vestibule or _____ to the rear of the Car on the ground, to make sure that there is nothing on the tracks for the duration of the move.

14. Keep Passengers off _____ and _____ vestibules and steps, and under no conditions allow anyone to ride on outside or on top of Car. Do not allow _____ to stand near open freight doors.
15. In case of any accident involving the Trolley Car, first _____ the Car as follows: 1) Shut off the _____, 2) Bring the Car to a quick but safe _____, 3) Latch the _____ firmly, 4) Remove _____, 5) Turn OFF the _____ Substation.
16. If there is danger of _____, return to Car Barn or Shed, remove Trolley Pole from Trolley Wire, and _____ Trolley Power Substation (see Rule ____). Operation may resume only when danger of lightning has passed.

18. The proper position for the Motorman is to stand _____ the Controller and the brake wheel, with one hand on each.
19. Always keep your primary _____ to the front of the Car when moving. Never leave the vestibule when the Car is moving.
20. The front headlight, if operable, must _____ be on when in motion. For convenience, both headlights may be left on, regardless of direction of travel. Operation after _____ without a headlight is forbidden.

21. Motorman must endeavor to _____ (with Controller shut off) whenever the Trolley Wheel is passing under a _____.
22. The Car may not exceed the speed of a _____ on the Main Track between the frog of Turnout 1 and Line Pole 10 in _____ direction.
23. The Car may not exceed the speed of a _____ on the House Track in either direction.
24. No On-Rail-Equipment may exceed the speed of a _____ on the Stall 1 track, Stall 2 track, or while in Turnout 5 or Turnout 7, in either direction.
25. No On-Rail-Equipment may exceed the speed of a _____ between Line Pole 1 and the _____ in either direction.
